

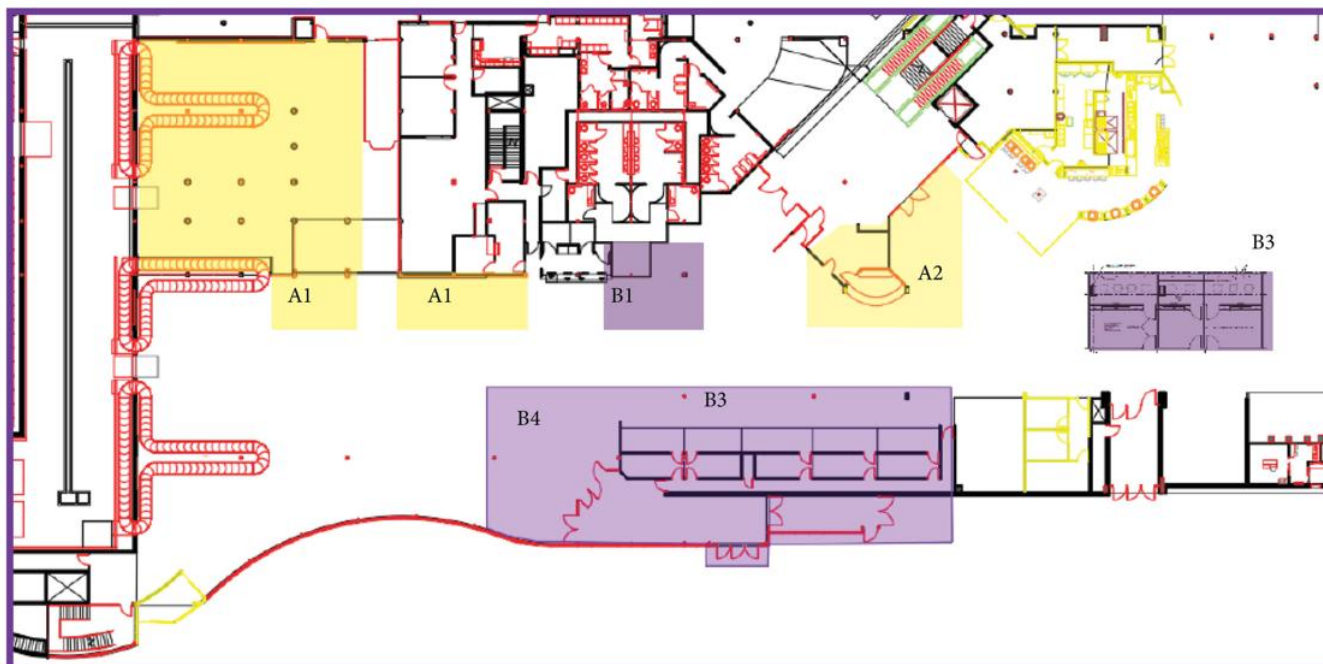

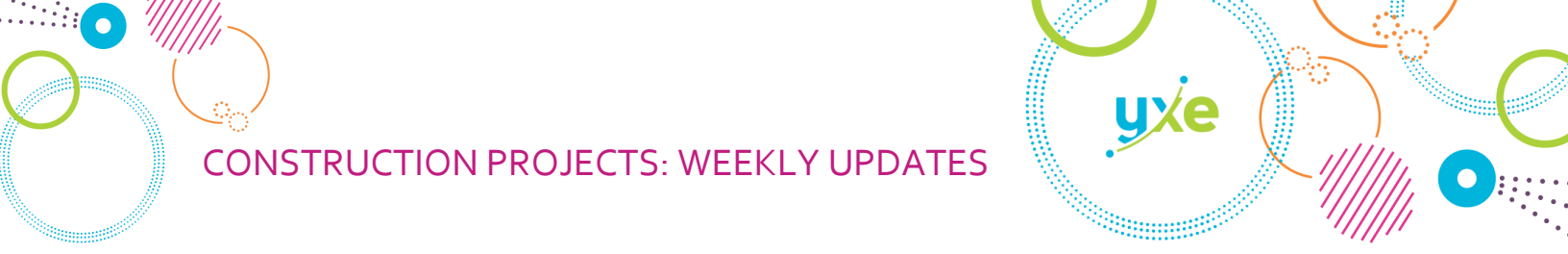

Project Name	Project Description	What to expect this week	Stakeholder Impacts
Escalator Targeted Completion: September 2026	As part of life-cycle replacement, we will be replacing our second main escalators that connect our pre-board screening area to all departure gates.	Construction continues	Guests are encouraged to use the elevator located around the hoarding wall if necessary.
Arrivals Hall Targeted Completion: See Chart Below	Final phase of our comprehensive terminal rehabilitation. This multi-phase project will last for approximately 18 months and result in periodic adjustments to traffic flow.	Work continues on Carousel 3 (A1), Information Booth (A2) Washrooms (B1), and Car Rental and Vestibule 4 (B3)	Carousel 3 remains closed (A1 below). Guests will use carousels 1 & 2 for all baggage. Temp lost/delayed baggage is available at the end of the check-in hall. Guests will have to access alternative washrooms in center core or the check-in hall. Direct car rental customers to the temp set up in center core (B3). Wayfinding continues to be adjusted as needed. Provide guests with hearing protection if they inquire about the noise. Ear plugs are located at Domestic Arrivals, Baggage Belts and the Info Desk. Vestibule 4 is closed. Use vestibule 3.
